



ExxonMobil to allow Apple Pay at the pump

Apple CEO Tim Cook has announced that the company will be introducing Apple Pay compatible Speedpass+ touchless payment system at all ExxonMobil gas stations in the U.S.

During Apple's quarterly earnings call, Cook revealed that ExxonMobil's Speedpass+ payment app for smartphones will now support Apple devices, which means iPhone users will be able to pay directly at the pump with their phones.

ExxonMobil's exclusive app Speedpass+ already functions in over 5,000 of the company's gas stations, according to Apple Insider.

Rival fuel operator Chevron started using Apple Pay at the pump in the summer of 2015 with a pilot program in the Bay Area. Customers can just scan their phones or Apple Watch at pump and get back on the road.
