



## OPW appoints Kevin Long as president

**OPW has announced today the appointment of Kevin Long as the company's new president.**

Kevin Long will be the new president of OPW, a Dover Company, replacing David Crouse after he was named president of the newly created Dover Fueling Solutions organization last December.

Kevin Long joined Dover in 2014 as the president of Colder Products Company, where he "led efforts to accelerate new product development, drive continuous improvement and develop talent within the organization," according to Dover Fluids President and CEO Bill Spurgeon.

After the acquisition of Wayne Fueling Systems, Dover combined the companies Wayne, Tokheim, ClearView, Fairbanks, ProGauge, and OPW's Fuel Management Systems into a new business, Dover Fueling Solutions.
