



USA: Electrify America hits 400th public EV charging station

Electrify America plans to install or have under development approximately 800 total charging stations with about 3,500 total chargers by December 2021.



Electrify America will open its 400th electric vehicle charging station this week, announced the company in a press release.

Electrify America opened its first site in May 2018. Since then, the company has rolled out more than 1,700 new chargers from coast-to-coast.

Electrify America also announced its plans to open 400 stations to the public, it has more than 100 stations permitted and another 150 in various phases of design and engineering.
