



Second Shell station in Ghana goes solar

Vivo Energy Ghana, Shell licensee, has reopened its second solar powered Shell service station in Community 2 at Tema.

The station is the second after Airport City Shell to be powered by solar energy to reduce the company's carbon footprint and ensure energy efficiency in its operations.

In an interview the Managing Director of Vivo Energy Ghana, Mr. Ben Hassan Ouattara said the initiative is in line with the goals the company has to reduce energy usage and impact on the environment.
