



France: Total to provide €50 million in fuel to healthcare staff

The French oil company will provide free fuel for professionals working in hospitals to support the struggle against the coronavirus.

The Total Group has decided to support healthcare staff of French hospitals mobilized in the fight against the Covid-19 virus by supplying them with fuel for their travel.

In consultation with France's health authorities, Total will provide hospitals with gasoline vouchers worth up to €50 million that can be used at Total stations.
