

Argentina: DAPSA sites to accept agro cards payments

Agropago platform is a digital solution that allows customers to pay with credit cards for the agricultural sector.

Destilería Argentina de Combustibles SA (DAPSA) has introduced the new Agropago solution to its entire agricultural and fuel station network in Argentina, reports surtidores.com.ar. Agropago is a digital platform that allows payments with credits cards for agricultural suppliers and producers in the country.

"During the month of June we signed an agreement between DAPSA and Agropago whereby the entire network can access the platform and process payments with all the agro cards," stated DAPSA's marketing manager, Marcelo Miani.

Agropago is in compliance with PCI certification and requires a single bank account to operate. The transactions made through this card are processed within a maximum of 72 hours. The platform also offers the possibility of processing operations using a mobile phone, tablet or computer.

"Our solution came about when we observed that payment methods in the agricultural sector are outdated, insecure and inefficient," said Agropago's commercial director, Gustavo Combes.
