



## Total Morocco opens a service station with new mobility concept

**New station includes solar energy, a wide range of fuels and a new food concept.**

Total Morocco has announced the opening of the Atlantis motorway service station, located on the Tangier-Rabat axis, near Larache. It is the first Total gas station in Morocco with the new mobility concept.

With an investment of 20 million dirhams (\$5.4 million) and covering 3,000m<sup>2</sup> of land, Atlantis is the 338th station and the 10th motorway of the Total network in Morocco. It's created 40 jobs, according to a press release.

The Atlantis station provides multi-service offer for motorists with three islands for the distribution of new generation fuels Total Advanced and Total Excellium, as well as a Total Quartz Auto Service maintenance bay.

The site is also partly powered by solar energy with 60 solar panels installed, which should cover around 30% of the needed energy – this is Total's 50% station in Morocco with solar energy.

It also includes 3 double-walled fuel tanks equipped with state-of-the-art leak detection, recycling systems for water and used oil at the maintenance bay, and an EV charging station, the 17th Total site to be able to power electric vehicles in Morocco.

In addition to a Bonjour café, a McDonald's restaurant and other services, the new stations includes Dar Dyafa, a new concept of authentic Moroccan catering, combining hospitality and craftsmanship, is a new Moroccan dining space.
