

ENOC Link rolls out new mobile fuelling service across UAE

The eLink Station, "a world-first", is designed to reduce the time needed to deploy a station, as well as to reduce space requirements.

The eLink Station is a mobile fuelling format that will enable motorists and customers access to fuelling, according to a company's press release.

The refuelling service solution is designed to reduce the time needed to deploy a station, as well as to reduce space requirements for a traditional fuel station. The mobile station implement carbon fiber "wings" to give customers shade while fuelling.

ENOC Link's eLink Station is equipped with a 30,000 litres tank and can fuel up to four vehicles simultaneously. The mobile station will offer consumers a supply of Special 95, Super 98, diesel and Biodiesel.
