

## PetroForum Africa plays host to 45 of Africa's leading oil companies spanning 22 countries

A total of 45 oil companies spanning 22 countries across Africa will meet with the world's leading fuel equipment suppliers in a dynamic program of conference sessions, technical workshops, service station visits, and one-to-one appointments and informal networking.

Fuel retailers range from local players to international oil companies – and control a combined portfolio of over 14,000 service stations.
