



Dunkin' Donuts to open 250 stores in South Africa

Dunkin' Donuts and Baskin-Robbins restaurants are expanding into South Africa for the first time, with more than 320 shops to open in the country.

Parent company Dunkin' Brands Inc has signed a master franchise agreement with Grand Parade Investments to expand two of its chains into the South African market, reported Reuters.

More than 250 Dunkin' Donuts and 70 Baskin-Robbins are expected to open over the coming years across the country, with a special focus on Cape Town and Johannesburg.

Gran Parade will also be in charge of launching Baskin-Robbins ice cream products in convenience stores and supermarkets over the coming years.
