

Ireland's Applegreen buys strategic sites in the UK

Irish forecourt operator Applegreen has acquired six service areas and one petrol station in the United Kingdom from the Carsley Group, reports the Irish Times.

Located along the A1 trunk road and offer food-to-go services, the seven sites provide a strategic growth to the company.

The acquisition worth £21 million is expected to finalize in the fourth quarter of this year and boost the company's service area presence in the UK.

The transaction will also complement Applegreen's dominance in Ireland and its expansion to the United States, where it acquired 42 sites in South Carolina.
