The Kroger's Culinary Development team today announced a new restaurant concept, Kitchen 1883, which offers a fresh take on new American comfort food.

Kitchen 1883's "New American Comfort" menu is a melting pot of American and international flavours. Located at 9003 U.S. Highway 42 in Union, Kentucky, the restaurant will operate daily offering lunch and dinner along with brunch on Saturdays and Sundays. The restaurant is scheduled to open in late October.
